Call for Self-Nominations Faculty Undergraduate Research Mentor Award Application Deadline: May 15, 2024

This award honors faculty members who have demonstrated exemplary mentoring of Pace undergraduate students in research and creative inquiry projects. For the pilot year of this award, recipients will receive \$500 and a plaque in recognition of their achievement.

<u>Eligibility</u>

- Full-time tenure-track or clinical faculty
- Record of sustained commitment to undergraduate research mentoring (minimum of five years of mentoring at Pace)
- Active participation in research-related activities on campus
- Significant contributions to the research and teaching culture of the Department, College, and University

Application Requirements

- A first-person written narrative 500-1000 words that speaks to the nominee's professional and personal commitment to undergraduate research mentoring with specific illustrations. The statement should include the candidate's mentoring philosophy and offer examples of student projects, approaches to mentoring, and innovative curriculum development that fosters a research culture at Pace.
- Curriculum vitae (CV) of the nominee that features undergraduate mentoring activities, highlighting (in yellow) mentored student projects, and publications, presentations, exhibitions, and/or performances with undergraduate coauthors.
- Two letters of support (up to two pages each), highlighting the nominee's contributions to the mentoring of students:
 - One from a faculty colleague or administrator
 - One from a current undergraduate student or graduate mentored by the nominee, explaining:
 - a) how the mentor contributed to their success and
 - b) how the mentor was a role model or inspiration
